The legal framework for university certificates and diplomas issued

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The University of El Oued confers academic degrees across three levels: Bachelor's, Master's, and PhD.

Bachelor's Degree

- 1. Description: A bachelor's degree is an undergraduate degree that typically requires three years of full-time study. It is granted in various fields of study, such as Bachelor of Science (B.S.), Bachelor of Engineering (B.E.), and others.
- 2. Entry requirements: The minimum baccalaureate rates accepted at Algerian universities determine the minimum grade a student must have obtained to qualify for admission into the program. This rate is determined annually. Foreign students are admitted into the required majors based on available capacity.
- 3. Study Mode: On-campus.
- 4. Program Type: Full-time.
- 5. Duration: 3 Years.
- Fees Currency: Education is provided free of charge, including accommodation, food, transportation, and students also receive an additional grant.
- 7. Employment after graduation: Upon completion of a bachelor's degree, graduates can pursue employment in public or private institutions, or they may choose to start their own projects, depending on their specialization.

Where the process of obtaining a bachelor's degree is regulated by a set of laws and ministerial decisions:

1- Decree No. 171 of 09 February 2023 laying down the modalities for re-registration and registration in training to obtain bachelor's and master's degrees, state engineer and architect, as well as the methods of organization, evaluation and gradation thereof.

2- Ministerial decisions for certificates and equivalencies

Master's Degree

- 1. Description: A master's degree is an advanced degree obtained after completing a bachelor's degree. It requires an additional two years of study. Examples include Master of Science (M.S.), Master of Business Administration (MBA), and others.
- 2. Entry requirements: To be eligible for a master's degree, students must hold a bachelor's degree in the relevant specialization, in addition to the baccalaureate.

Foreign students are admitted into the required majors based on available capacity.

Doctoral Degree (Ph.D.)

- 1. Description: A doctoral degree is the highest level of academic accomplishment, typically obtained after several years of specialized research and the completion of a dissertation.
- 2. Entry requirements: To pursue a doctoral degree, students must have already obtained a master's degree in the relevant specialization, in addition to meeting the baccalaureate requirements. They are also required to pass a competition for admission to the doctoral program. The availability of positions for this competition is determined annually through ministerial decisions aimed at enhancing university institutions.
- 3. Study Mode: Blended (combination of on-campus and online learning).
- 4. Program Type: Full-time.
- 5. Duration: 3 Years.
- 6. Fees Currency: Education is provided free of charge, including accommodation, food, transportation, and students also receive an additional grant.
- 7. Employment after graduation: Depending on their area of specialization, individuals with a Ph.D. degree can pursue careers as university professors or researchers in research centers. They also have the opportunity to work in public or private institutions or establish their own projects.

Domains and specializations: El Oued University offers numerous specializations and fields of study, aligned with ministerial decisions, encompassing various domains, including law and political science, economics, management and business sciences, humanities and social sciences, sciences and techniques of physical and sports activities, Arabic language and literature, letters and foreign languages, architecture, urban planning and city management, earth and universe sciences, science and technology, mathematics and computer science, natural and life sciences, and the science of matter.
