## Preamble to the Conference



The achievement of economic, social development and the guarantee of food security, are based on the agricultural sector and its main integrated branches. Starting with the branch of desert agriculture, the branch of agriculture of the high plateaus and the branch of coastal agriculture. The desert agriculture in the Algerian economy is an essential source of ensuring sustainable food security, reducing dependence on external sources of food, rebalancing the food trade balance, gaining a share in African and European regional markets, creating added value and economic diversification, and contributing to the employment. Reduce unemployment rates to achieve social development and ensure social stability.

The development of the Desert agriculture sector in the Algerian economy, is linked to the levels of support and the nature of the accompaniment. Encouraging agricultural investment in the domestic and foreign industrial sector, will also enhance the level of integration, and balanced productive partnership of interests.

Therefore, the protection and preservation of agricultural land is a priority for every government policy aimed at promoting and developing agricultural production. Due to the limited arable area available, which represents only 3.5% of the total area of the country, and that the irrigated area is not more than eighth(1/8).Hence the desert agriculture in southern Algeria, especially in El-Oued City, comes as one of the most important tributaries of this agricultural sector, after its production capacities have increased in meeting local needs and exporting many crops.

The State's interest in the agricultural sector, especially in the Desert agriculture branch, had increased and that had been reflected in the Government's programmes and public policy.Which had given priority to national production based on local agricultural inputs.In addition, the tendency to modernize the sector to create wealth and make it an essential alternative to energy exports in the medium and long perspective.

Based on the above, the problem of the conference can be formulated through the following questions:

-1 What is the reality of desert agriculture in general and the level achieved by the state of El-Oued in particular? This means that we are looking at the reality of the constraints and alternatives available, and identifying opportunities with how to value them?

-2 What are the main axes to build an integrated strategy to achieve sustainable desert agricultural development?
